Chicago's **Museum of Science & Industry** will keep you busy for a full day, even more. Inside is a real Boeing 727, a coal mine, German U-505 submarine plus "The Great Train Story", a 3,500-sq. ft. HO railroad that tells the story of transportation from Seattle to Chicago.

**The Shedd Aquarium** opened in the

1930's and is considered to be the world's largest indoor aquarium. It is home to almost 8,000 underwater creatures (650 species of fish, reptiles, amphibians, invertebrates, birds and mammals from waters around the world), displayed in their natural surroundings. The "Wild Reef" exhibit features the largest and most diverse collection of sharks in North America
