DAY 6: Palma de Majorca, Spain. The capital city of the Mediterranean's largest Balearic Island has nearly two-thirds of the total population live in Palma. Poised on a sea wall above the marina, the city's massive gothic cathedral is a breathtaking sight. Known locally as La Seo, it is home to the world's largest rose window as well as an ornate wrought-iron canopy above the altar designed by Baldacchino. (B,L,D)

DAY 7: Cartagena, Spain. Nestled in a natural harbor surrounded by five hills, the walled seaport of Cartagena features a scattering of Roman ruins. Tours take you to the remains of the 13th century Cathedral of Santa Maria and the remarkable Roman Theatre discovered in 1987. The theatre dates from the 1st century BC and was once considered the finest in Spain. (B,L,D)

DAY 8: At Sea. (B,L,D)

DAY 9: Funchal, Madeira. The island of Madeira is located in the Atlantic Ocean off the coast of Morocco. For over 100 years tourists have enjoyed its rugged volcanic peaks, beautiful tropical coastline and a climate that's never too hot or cold. Madeira lace and Madeira wine are both still produced here in the Old World tradition. (B,L,D)

DAY 10: Santa Cruz, Canary Islands. Largest of the Canary Archipelago, the Spanish isle of Tenerife has many different regions, each with its own characteristics. Enjoy a panoramic city tour of Santa Cruz and visit Pyramid Park, an area discovered by the world-famous adventurer Thor Heyerdahl. No one knows where the pyramids came from, but no one who sees them can forget these strange formations. (B,L,D)
