Autumn comes to the New England states! It's the most wonderful time of the year because across the Northeast, Mother Nature paints her colorful displays. And, you'll be right there to witness brilliant oranges, reds and yellows! Ah, autumn is in the air! Can't you smell it? Breathe it in!

DAY 1: Welcome to Boston and transfer to famous **Quincy Market**. For over 250 years this place has played an integral role in the life of Boston residents. There are 100 shops, carts and artisans! Your "Welcome Dinner" takes place at the **Durgin Park Restaurant** at Quincy Market. Overnight **La Quinta** in Andover, MA. (D)

DAY 2: Maine Sights. After breakfast travel to **Stonewall Kitchens** in Maine. Named for the graceful stonewalls surrounding the original farm, you'll see how they make those delicious jams and jellies.

Later, tour of the coastal villages of **Kennybunk** and **Kennebunkport**. Drive past the George Bush estate at Walker's Point, hear the history of these ship building towns and the legend of the Wedding Cake House. Enjoy free time for shopping and lunch in the Dock Square area.

This afternoon you'll have a photo stop at a Maine lighthouse before heading to Portland, Maine's largest city. Enjoy the Old Port Exchange, Portland's restored waterfront district. You'll ride the **Maine Narrow Gauge Railroad** for a scenic look over Portland Harbor, overlooking the Calendar Islands of Casco Bay. Visit the museum here that features the historic "two-footer" trains that ran between many towns in rural Maine. Tonight, sit down to a Maine Lobster Bake. Overnight **Ogunquit Resort** in Ogunquit, ME. (B,D)

DAY 3: Fall Viewing. Travel to New Hampshire for a fall foliage ride on the **Conway Scenic Railway**. Afterward, embark upon the scenic **Kancamangus**, one of the most scenic routes in America in the White Mountains. Stops include the Albany Covered Bridge and Rocky Gorge. This evening dine at **Woodwards** and followed by two nights **Comfort Inn Mountain Club** at Loon, NH. (B,D)

DAY 4: Lake Cruise. This morning board the 230' **MS Mount Washington** for a fall cruise on Lake Winnepesaukee. Your ship takes you to the port of Wolfeboro, the oldest summer resort in America.

Later, you'll visit the **Wright Museum** housing aircraft and tanks from World War II. Later, you'll visit the **Old Country Store** in Moultonborough. Tonight, hop aboard the
