



# Itinerary

Isn't it time you discovered our Polynesian state of Hawaii? There is something very magical about the Hawaiian Islands! Images of lush mountains, cascading waterfalls, steamy volcanoes and white sand beaches come to mind! See the land of Aloha for yourself on a fantastic Royal Caribbean cruise around the islands of Kauai, Maui, Oahu and The Big Island!

**DAYS 1-2: Hawaii 5-0!** Arrive Honolulu and transfer to the **Aston Waikiki Beach**, located across the street from world famous Waikiki Beach. You'll have two nights to explore and the Aston's "Breakfast on the Beach" each morning! Walk to the International Marketplace, take a tour to Pearl Harbor or enjoy a traditional Luau. Hawaii's capital is indeed the jewel city of the Pacific. From Diamond Head to the only royal palace ever built on U.S. soil. The Radiance of the Seas overnights at the Aloha Tower with shops and restaurants. Why not have lunch in nearby Chinatown or take a free trolley to Hilo Hattie's, the "Store of Hawaii"? (B,L,D)

**DAY 5: Nawiliwili, Kauai.** Hawaii's Garden Isle is a tropical paradise with towering ocean cliffs and lush verdant valleys, pristine rain forests and cascading waterfalls as well as some of the world's most photographed beaches. Take a helicopter ride over Waimea Canyon (*the Grand Canyon of the Pacific*), cruise Wailua River to the Fern Grotto, explore the shores of Lumahai Beach and Bali Ha'i Mountains, made famous in the musical "South Pacific". (B,L,D)

**DAYS 6-7: Old Lahaina, Maui.** The Hawaiian phrase "Maui No Ka Oi" means "Maui is the best." Explore the historic whaling town of Lahaina. Tour Haleakala National Park and its 10,000-foot volcano crater. Experience the scenic road to remote Hana. (B,L,D)

**DAY 8: Kona, The Big Island.** is Called "The Orchid Isle" and "The Volcano Island", the island of Hawaii is 4,050 square miles and home to snow-capped, 14,000-ft. peaks of Mauna Loa and Mauna Kea. Located along Hawaii's western shore is the dry Kona Coast, region of endless lava fields and golden Pacific sunsets. The clear waters are
