The Panhandle is home to Palo Duro Canyon-the Grand Canyon of Texas, and to "Texas"- the highly praised outdoor musical! Your tour to Palo Duro country features an authentic cowboy breakfast on the rim of Palo Duro Canyon and the Panhandle Plains Historical Museum - called the Smithsonian of Texas. Join us on another delightful, music-filled summer treat!

DAY 1: Fandangle Musical. Enjoy a fun "get-acquainted" day, so sit back and watch the landscape roll by. You'll bed down at the **Holiday Inn Express** in Abilene.

Before the sun sets you'll wander over to nearby Albany for the **Fandangle Parade**. Then sit down to sumptuous beans, biscuits & BBQ before witnessing the wonderful "**Fort Griffin Fandangle**". This is the oldest outdoor pageant in Texas, and you have a reserved box seat for this annual event! (D)

DAY 2: The West is Alive. After breakfast, it's time to hitch up the wagon and ride to **Frontier Texas!** You'll be thrilled with this state-of-the-art western museum.

Later in the afternoon journey to the **Panhandle Plains Museum**. Nicknamed "**The Smithsonian of Texas**", the museum features the works of Charles Russell and Frederick Remington. It is Texas' largest historical museum housing over three million artifacts.

Tonight, call the **Holiday Inn Express** in Canyon home for two nights. Dinner will be at **Feldman's Wrong Way Diner**. (B,D)

DAY 3: Texas Musical Drama. Start your day with a real cowboy breakfast at the **River Breaks Ranch**. The ranch hands pile on the eggs, sausage and sourdough biscuits, all cooked over a mesquite fire. Pard, these are good eats and there are music and mischief around!

When you've had your fill, your coach takes on the **Palo Duro Canyon** trail. Carved out of the Great Plains, the canyon stretches 120-
