Day 1: Arrive at the Salt Lake Airport today by 3:00 p.m. and transfer to the hotel by taxi or Uber. Upon arrival at the hotel, meet your Rockport Tours tour director who will assist with hotel check-in. The rest of the day is free to explore Salt Lake City on your own. Join the group for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant this evening. (D)

Day 2: Depart Salt Lake City and travel north through Utah, Southeastern Idaho, and Western Wyoming on the way to Jackson, WY. This afternoon, enter Grand Teton National Park for sightseeing. Dinner tonight will be at one of the fantastic local restaurants in Jackson. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Enter Grand Teton National Park and start your day with a wonderful Float

Trip down the Snake River. Then enjoy wildlife and photography opportunities as you tour the park including Jenny Lake, Jackson Lake and Coulter Bay and more. It will be an afternoon of sightseeing and wildlife watching. Return to Jackson for a relaxing evening in town. (B, L)

Day 4: Drive north through Grand Teton to Yellowstone National Park and explore the West Thumb Geyser Basin, Yellowstone Lake, Hayden Valley and Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone. Lunch will be on own today. In the afternoon, visit Mammoth Hot Springs to view the beautiful terraces, then visit Norris Geyser Basin before traveling through the Madison River Valley on your way to West Yellowstone. Evening free to explore on own. (B)

Day 5: Today you will focus on the Geyser Basins, explore Fountain Paint Pots, Old Faithful and the Old Faithful Lodge for Lunch. Afterwards explore Grand Prismatic Spring, Firehole Geyser Basin, Black Sand Basin, and other areas. There will be some great walks and multiple opportunities to enjoy watching the wildlife within the park. Evening free in West Yellowstone. (B, L)

Day 6: This morning will be spent exploring just outside of Yellowstone in Island Park with stops at Big Springs and Mesa Falls. Continue south through the potato fields of Idaho and then along the shores of the Great Salt Lake. Arrive back in Salt Lake City and join the group for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. After dinner, return to your hotel and say goodbye to your Southwest Adventure Tours tour director. (B, L, D)

Day 7: After breakfast, transfer on own by taxi or Uber to the Salt Lake Airport for your departure flight home.(B)
