Oct. 2: Fly from Houston to Boston and check into your hotel, the Courtyard by Marriott.

Oct. 3: Today we will do a short tour of Boston including Quincy Market. This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner at Maggiano's Italian Restaurant.

This evening, enjoy a buffet dinner before checking into your

hotel.

Begin with a scenic cruise on Lake Winnepesaukee aboard the M/S Mount Washington, arriving in Wolfeboro, the oldest summer resort in America. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping in this charming lakeside town before visiting the Wright Museum, dedicated to the World War II era with exhibits highlighting both military history and everyday life. Later, board the Winnepesaukee Scenic Railroad for a memorable turkey dinner train ride along the lake before returning to your hotel.

Oct. 7: After breakfast, depart for Vermont and enjoy a visit to the Vermont Country Store in Weston, filled with nostalgic treasures and classic New England charm. Continue to Bennington for an included lunch at the historic Publyk House before visiting the Norman Rockwell Museum, home to many of the illustrator's original works. Later, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before checking into your hotel in the Berkshires.

Oct. 8: Enjoy breakfast at your leisure this morning before departing for home with wonderful memories of colorful foliage, mountain railways, charming villages, and classic New England scenery.
