

YOUR ITINERARY

Aug 22: Vancouver. Fly to Vancouver. Take a cab or if available hotel shuttle to the hotel and meet your group leader.

Aug 23: Radiance of the Seas. Today you will board the Radiance to begin your journey!

Aug 24: Inside Passage: Begin with a day at sea. Enjoy the inside passage as mountains and trees pass the ship on either side!

Aug 25: Juneau. Once you arrive you'll find majestic views and rich culture in every corner. With its snowcapped mountains, misty rainforests, massive glaciers and bounty of wildlife, Alaska's remote state capital is the perfect place to dive into nature.

Aug 26: Icy Strait Point: Icy Strait Point is one tiny port that's big on Alaskan wilderness and Native culture. Opened a decade ago by the Huna Tlingit Native Alaskans, it's easily one of the best spots in the region for fishing and whale watching. Dive into Native Alaska culture at a tribal dance show or pay a visit to Hoonah, Alaska's largest Tlingit village.

Aug 27: Sitka. A captivating blend of

Russian, Tlingit, and American history. Snow-capped peaks, Mount Edgecumbe's majesty, and abundant wildlife await. Kayak with sea otters, fish for giant halibut, and explore Baranof Island. Discover endless adventure under the midnight sun.

Aug 28: Skagway: The tiny town of Skagway still looks like it did during the Klondike Gold Rush over 100 years ago— and today it remains an outpost for thrilling Alaskan adventure. An old-time street car ride along bustling Broadway Street reveals well-preserved buildings, including the state's oldest hotel. You can see engraved walrus tusks at the Corrington Museum, or get lost in riveting historical reenactments around town.

Aug 29: Hubbard Glacier: Hubbard Glacier is 76 miles long, 7 miles wide, and 350 feet above the waterline where it meets the bay. Watch as massive chunks of ice crash into the bay, a process known as calving that the Tlingit people call "White Thunder."

Aug 30: Seward: Enjoy a scenic drive in your deluxe motor coach to the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center to visit the animals under expert care. Enjoy a stroll and lunch on your own during the stop in downtown Anchorage before traveling further into the interior. From 4:30 p.m., your time in Talkeetna is your own. A stroll down the historic main street reveals this funky town's singular mix of lively brew pubs, roadhouse restaurants, welcoming cafes and

unique local shops. Overnight at the Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge.

Aug 31: Talkeetna and Denali: Take in the mountain views on the drive to Denali. Experience the untamed beauty of Denali National Park on the Denali Natural History Tour, while scouting the tundra and forest for wildlife with a park ranger. After your tour, Denali is yours to explore. Hike the scenic trails that surround the lodge. Or book an optional excursion, like flightseeing or rafting on the Nenana River. Overnight at Denali Park Village.

Sep 01: Denali/Talkeetna/Anchorage. The morning is open for optional excursions, with a guided wilderness hike and meeting the sled-racing dogs of the Husky Homestead among the possibilities. Board the glass-domed railcars of the Wilderness Express® train for your journey to Anchorage. From 8:30 p.m., you're free to explore Anchorage and its vibrant city life. Enjoy a romantic dinner or stroll an urban trail in the evening sunlight. Overnight at the Anchorage Marriott.

Sep. 2: Anchorage. Your Adventure Specialist will ensure you transfer to the airport on time.
